Peace in Vietnam  
At 10 p.m. on January 23, 1973, President Nixon announced that an agreement had been reached in Paris, France, between U.S. negotiator Dr. Henry Kissinger and North Vietnamese negotiator Le Duc Tho (for the Paris Peace Accords, a ceasefire in Vietnam would begin on January 27. All U.S. troops were to be withdrawn from Vietnam immediately, and all POWs were to be released within sixty days. President Nixon proclaimed the ceasefire a "peace with honor."

Even though the American forces were withdrawn, the North Vietnamese Communists did not keep the terms of the Paris Accords. Within two years, South Laos (Laos), and Cambodia were the Communist North Vietnamese, fell to forces on April 30, 1975.

The first time a vocabulary word is used, it is defined and pronunciation shown. We suggest they be read aloud to assure proper pronunciation by the student. At lower levels new vocabulary is underlined in color and often pronunciation again shown to aid student mastery.

Each unit has an associated **Checkup (unit quiz)** that reveals areas of strength and weakness, providing opportunity for praise as well review and reinforcement. Content mastery is crucial each step of the way.
